CALL FOR MEDALS & PARTICIPATION

International Workshop for Medal-Sculptures in Art-Valley 51

from 13th June – 25th July 2015

To all the FIDEM delegates & vice-delegates,

In order to diversify the medal-sculptures as much as possible, it would be great to receive works from all countries in different styles:

- not more than 10 different medals per country
- a maximum of 1 medal per participating artist
- a preference for a cast medal between 10 and 15 cm (1 or 2 sides is/are ok)
- no special creation needed, an existing work is fine
- struck medals are also accepted in a size of 7 to 12 cm
- a sheet with name of the artist & title of the medal
- a photo of the artist and the medal

The medals will be used as a part of medal-sculptures in order to commemorate the XXXIV FIDEM Congress in 2016, and will be inaugurated on different FIDEM locations such as the cities of Namur and Ghent. The medals may be transformed by welding to another medal or a piece of metal. Therefore we only can accept medals in metal.

Please note that if you wish to participate at the workshop I need the included form no later than 15th April. If you wish to send a medal please let me know before 30th April that you wish to participate with a medal. The medals for this International Workshop 2015 can be sent in until 30th May 2015.
